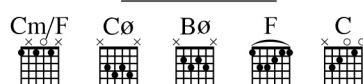

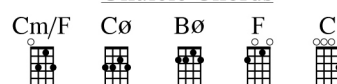

Beginner uke players can skip the G (top) string on the Cø and Bø if it's too tricky.
